

`console.log` is not debugging

It tells you a value existed. Not why.

Label your logs

The object shorthand names each value for you.



javascript

```
// which one is which?  
console.log(user, order, total)  
  
// labeled, every time  
console.log({ user, order, total })
```

See structure, not soup

`console.table(rows)` renders objects as columns instead of a wall of text.

Freeze time

A breakpoint pauses the call stack so you inspect every variable in scope at once — then step through.
